 - (b) Why were some books left out in the composing of the New Testament Canon? (12mks)

SECTION B: THE GOSPELS

- 3. (a) Examine the various forms of temptations Jesus went through in Mark's gospel. (13mks)
 (b) Assess the effects of temptations to modern Christians today. (12mks)
- 4. (a) Analyse the factors that led to the death of John the Baptist in Mark's gospel. (13mks)

(b) Discuss the lessons that modern Christian leaders draw from the above incident.

- 5. Compare the miracle of walking on water in Mark's gospel (mark 6: 45–51) to the sign of walking on water in John's gospel (John 6.:16-21) (25mks)
- 6. Examine the role of John the Baptist ministry in the gospels of Mark and John. (25mks)
- 7. "...., he went to him and asked him to go to Capernaum and heal his son, who was about to die. (John 4:47 GNB)>
 - (a) Examine the meaning of Jesus healing an official's son in the fourth gospel.
 - (b) Discuss the relevance of the above sign to modern Christians in Uganda today.

- (a) Account for Jesus' crucifixion in John's gospel (John 19:17 -27). (13mks)
 - (b) Examine the significance of Jesus' suffering to Christians in Uganda today.

- 9. (a) Analyse the circumstances which prompted Paul to teach on spiritual gifts in his first letter to the Corinthians. (13mks)
 - (b) Examine the ways in which Paul responded to the challenges of spiritual gifts. (12mks)
- 10. "Let me tell you my brothers and sisters that the gospel I preach is not of human origin". (Gal 1:11 GNB)
 - (a) Justify Paul's defence of his apostleship. (13mks)
 - (b) Examine the areas in which modern evangelists in Uganda would encounter opposition from other Christians . (12mks)
- 11. To what extent was the letter of first Peter (1peter) addressed to the Gentile Christians ? (25mks)
- 12. (a) Justify James' statement that "faith without actions is dead". (James 2:26)
 - (b) Examine the ways in which Christians in Uganda today can put their faith into action. (12mks)
