SCHOOL RULES AND REGULATIONS/ DISCIPLINARY POLICY

Bethany High School has a Christian foundation. The rules and regulations governing the school are based on this belief.

Since Christ is Lord of all life, all activities in school should be in accordance with His laws. In any community, the acts of an individual member, whether good or bad will affect the whole body. An active concern for the good of the school and for the wide community outside the college is expected of every individual.

True Education is a must concern with training of character and acquisition of knowledge.

Learning to be honest, hardworking, helpful and well-mannered is as important as learning academic subjects.

General School Rules

- 1. Obedience and Respect to school authorities is expected from all students. (these include Administrators, members of staff, Prefectorial body and class monitors). Failure to obey the above may lead to an expulsion.
- 2. Dodging of classes, Tests and Exams are Serious offences, which are punishable by a suspension of not less than 2 weeks, If the Habit persists, it may lead to indefinite suspension.
- 3. Cheating of Exams or Tests is a Grave offence. Culprits will be punished by 2weeks suspension and disqualified from the entire examinations session. If the habit persists, this may lead to an indefinite suspension.
- 4. Drinking alcohol, smoking cigarettes, shisha and use of drugs, Gambling, Fighting, Bullying, Teasing and Stealing are very serious offences. Culprits will be expelled from the school with immediate effect.
- 5. Immoral relationships
 - (a) Unhealthy boy –girl relationship between students is highly prohibited. Students are to clearly stick and use facilities according to their sex designation. Failure to comply is punishable
 - (b) Any form of sexual relationships is punishable by an indefinite suspension.
- 6. English is the official language of communication at school, both in class and outside. Any use of vulgar language is highly prohibited and culprits will face disciplinary action.
- 7. Proper school uniform must be worn at school and when leaving or coming to school. Misuse of school uniform is punishable by buying a new set of uniform immediately.
- 8. Wearing artificial make-up, ear/nose rings, bracelets, and necklaces at school is not allowed. Long, plaited, braided, treated hair is not permitted as well as elaborate haircuts/styles. Short nails with no cutex/nail vanish must be kept. Culprits will be punished.
- 9. Electronic gadgets are not permitted at school. That is to say; cameras, radio, mobile phones, mp3 players, etc. anyone found in possession of the above will be confiscated for good and offenders facing further disciplinary. Student's laptops and tablets should be handed over to the respective offices in case of study purposes.
- 10. A student who maliciously or carelessly, damages, loses, misuses, mishandles school property (and even fellow students' property) will be required to replace it and will not be allowed in school until he does so. If the act persists the culprit will be expelled from school.

- 11. Trading activity amongst students or with staff/unauthorized public, borrowing /lending of uniforms, shoes, clothes and money etc is not allowed. Culprits will serve 2-weeks suspension from school.
- 12. Dormitories are out of bounds during class time and other designated school programmes. Culprits will be punished by internal suspension with hard labour, continuous behaviour may lead to indefinite suspension.
- 13. Staff Quarters, the staff room and the school kitchen areas are out of bounds to students unless authorized or in case of emergency. Offenders face serious disciplinary action.
- 14. No student once in school is allowed to leave without written permission from the administration. Culprits will be indefinitely suspended from school. When released from school, the student must return with a signed gate pass by parent.
- 15. School meals are compulsory and must be taken within the dinning hall as scheduled. No cooking or carrying cooked foodstuffs into the dormitories by students. Culprits will serve a 1-week's internal suspension with hard labour.
- 16. Self- medication is not allowed without the school Nurse's knowledge or consent and Bed- rest can only be taken with her written permission. Those with chronic illnesses must carry along sufficient medication and declare it to the nurse. All students must have medical examination report.
- 17. Students' visitors are only allowed on official visitation days unless prior appointment is made with the office. Students' visitors must carry along the school visitor's card and are not allowed into dormitories. Students should not receive visitors during class time.
- 18. Students must ensure and maintain a hygienic environment by cleaning their compound, classrooms and dormitories as scheduled and observe excellent personal hygiene. Offenders will be subjected to hard labour or be sent home for parental counseling.
- 19. un necessary noise making at any time in school is unacceptable. Culprits will face disciplinary action.
- * The above school regulations are designed with the aim of promoting a cordial and harmonious school environment.
- * It is the duty of school to ensure and shape the character of its students to grow into disciplined and responsible citizens.
- * Compliance with these rules and regulations is thus expected without question.
